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Dock Builder's Pledge

Please initial the following prompts to complete the LLA Dock Builder's Pledge:

I, the authorized representative of the undersigned company engaged in the business of building, repairing, installing, and removing docks on Lake Sidney Lanier, do hereby pledge and commit that the undersigned company will comply with all of the following Best Business Practices while conducting activities on Lake Lanier boat docks, USACE property and associated worksites:

- A. Practice and instruct its employees on the importance of keeping Lake Lanier clean and safe at all times.

- B. Ensure that any and all materials removed from existing docks and related structures are promptly and properly disposed of as part of the work to be performed under the company's contracts.

- C. Maintain all staging areas on the lake utilized for "in-progress" work in a professional manner, including but not limited to removing all materials and debris immediately upon completion of work on each dock.

D. Ensure that NO docks, vessels, or related structures or materials are abandoned by the company, its employees, its sub-contractors, or anyone associated with the company on Lake Lanier or its shoreline under any circumstances. Only when prior permission has been granted by the USACE, with SPECIFIC direction and timeline, shall my company leave any dock or part thereof in any unauthorized location on Lake Lanier or its shoreline.

E. Adhere to flotation manufacturers' installation instructions and use approved fasteners for securing flotation to dock frames.

F. Comply with all local, state, and federal requirements and guidelines for all types of dock work on Lake Lanier.

G. Properly register with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Buford Project.

H. Have a current business license and current insurance including, but not limited to, General Liability and Workers' Compensation coverage.

I. Provide employee training on proper disposal of dock components, boat lifts, and floats.

J. Participate in Laker Lanier Association's annual Shore Sweep efforts, both in the pre-Shore Sweep clean-ups and on Shore Sweep Day.
